¹ **Lock&Track** and the *LTclient* software both include Photo Imaging capabilities at no extra charge. However, separate charges may apply to obtain and install necessary a network camera, pan-tilt-zoom mounting and other hardware.

² This BedRate applies only when the **Lock&Force Sheriff's Information System** is bundled with Basic **Lock&Track** (LT). Separate rates apply if **Lock&Force** is subscribed *without* jail management modules.

³ These BedRates apply only as additional modules to Basic **Lock&Track** (LT), which is a prerequisite.

⁴ This BedRate for Comprehensive (COM) Service includes *all* other **Lock&Track** and **Lock&Force** modules, and represents the maximum rate for the **Lock&Track Online** Service.

Definition of terms

BedRate is the *sum* of the BedRates of the **Lock&Track Online** modules, up to a maximum of **\$30** for any aggregate of modules, selected for use at the Customer's correctional facility or facilities, excluding Comprehensive (COM) which *includes all L&T Online* modules for the same **\$30** rate.

NumberOfBeds is the total rated capacity (actual number of beds) of the Customer's correctional facility or facilities.

The MonthlyFee is the product of BedRate times NumberOfBeds:

$$\text{MonthlyFee} = \text{BedRate} \times \text{NumberOfBeds}$$

The Service SetupFee is:

$$\text{SetupFee} = 2 \times \text{MonthlyFee}$$

Examples

For example: If your organization wants to use *all* of the modules in the **Lock&Track Online** Service, the Comprehensive (COM) option, and your facility's capacity is 100 beds, then your MonthlyFee is $\$30 \times 100$ or **\$3,000.00**.

Another example: If you want only the Basic **L&T** Service (LT) plus the Day Reporting Center functions (DRC), then your MonthlyFee is $(\$15 + \$3) \times 50$, or **\$900.00**.

And: If you want the Basic **L&T** Service (LT), plus the **Lock&Force** Sheriff's module (LF), plus the Inmate Accounts module (IA), for a facility capacity of 75 beds, then your MonthlyFee is $(\$15 + \$9 + \$3) \times 75 = \27×75 , or **\$2,025.00**.

Finally: if you want the Basic **L&T** Service (LT), plus the **Lock&Force** Sheriff's module (LF), plus the Inmate Accounts module (IA), the Inmate Services module (IS), and the Facilities Management module (FM), for a facility capacity of 150 beds, then your MonthlyFee is $(\$15 + \$9 + \$3 + \$3 + \$3) \times 75 = \33×150 — but this is capped at \$30, so the final fee is $\$30 \times 150$, or **\$4,500.00**.

In all cases, a one-time **Service SetupFee** is assessed in order to defray such setup/startup tasks as new user accounts creation, network connectivity engineering and assurance, jailhouse model data design and entry, and other minor miscellaneous setup tasks. This **Service SetupFee** is assessed at two times (2×) your first Monthly-Fee (e.g., **\$6,000**, **\$1,800**, **\$4,050** and **\$9,000** for the examples above, respectively).

The **Service SetupFee** is *non-refundable*.
